



## Sections of the NRM Act that relate to declared plants and animals

<b>Section of NRM Act</b>	<b>Description</b>
Section 175(1)	Movement of plants or produce or goods carrying declared plants into a control area.
Section 175(2)	Movement of plants or produce or goods carrying declared plants on public road within a control area.
Section 175(3)	Movement from infested to un-infested/unaffected land
Section 176(2)	Possession
Section 176(3)	Cultivation
Section 177(1)	Prohibition sale of declared plant
Section 177(2)	Prohibition sale of items carrying declared plant
Section 178	Declaration by vendor
Section 179(2)	Offence to release
Section 180(1)	Notification of presence of declared plants to the NRM group.
Section 180(2)	Notification of presence of declared plants from the NRM authority to the Chief Officer.
Section 180(3)	Notification of presence of declared plants from Chief Officer to NRM Group and Board
Section 181(2)	Requirement to control within boundaries of land by instruction of authorised officer
Section 182(1)	Owner of land to destroy declared plants.
Section 182(2)	Owner of land to control declared plants.
Section 182(3)	Owner of land to take measures for control or specified treatment
Section 185(1)	NRM authorities may recover certain costs from owners of land adjoining road reserves.
